**LOCAL, NATIONAL, GLOBAL**

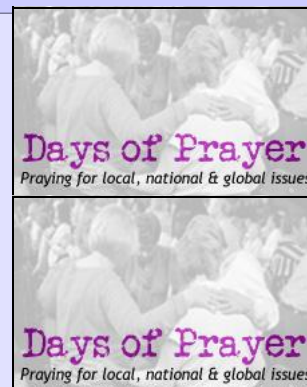

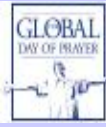
